Communion Antiphon:

Mary treasured all these words, reflecting on them in her heart.

WEDNESDAY Weekday

Entrance Antiphon:

Abraham put his faith in God, and his faith was considered as justifying him. The Lord made a Covenant with Abraham.

Responsorial Psalm:

Communion Antiphon:

THURSDAY

St Cyril of Alexandria, Bishop & Doctor

Cyril was a defender of the faith at the Council of Ephesus and fought against heresy as a great defender of the mystery of the Incarnation and the dogma of Mary's Divine Motherhood. He is a Doctor of the Church and died in 444.

Entrance Antiphon:

The Lord is the strength of his people, a saving refuge for the one he has anointed. Save your people, Lord, and bless your heritage, and govern them for ever.

First Reading: Genesis 16:1-12,15-16

Hagar bears Abram a son.

Responsorial Psalm:

O give thanks to the Lord for he is good.

Gospel Acclamation:

Alleluia, Alleluia! The word of God is something alive and active: it can judge secret emotions and thoughts. Alleluia!

Gospel: Matthew 7:21-19

The wise man built his house on a rock.

Communion Antiphon:

The eyes of all look to you, Lord, and you give them their food in due season.

FRIDAY

THE MOST SACRED HEART OF JESUS

Entrance Antiphon:

The designs of his Heart are from age to age, to rescue their souls from death, and to keep them alive in famine.

The Gloria

First Reading: Ezekiel 34: 11-16

I myself will pasture my sheep. I myself will show them where to rest.

Responsorial Psalm:

The Lord is my shepherd; there is nothing I shall want.

Second Reading: Romans 5: 5-11

The love of God has been poured into our hearts.

Gospel Acclamation:

Alleluia, Alleluia! Shoulder my yoke and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart. Alleluia!
